- SCD can affect anyone, although it predominantly affects people from African and

- Approximately 15,000 people in the UK have sickle cell disorder
- Almost 300 babies are born in the UK with sickle cell each year
- Children with SCD are at increased risk for stroke, the risk is highest between the ages of 2


